

Trade in and licensed production of major conventional weapons: Imports sorted by recipient. Deals with deliveries or orders made 1975-2005

This register lists major weapons on order or under delivery, or for which the licence was bought and production was under way or completed during 1975-2005. 'Year(s) of deliveries' includes aggregates of all deliveries and licensed production since the beginning of the contract.
